**WHEREAS**, Christopher and Jennifer Riefler are the owners of approximately 5.2 acres of land, commonly referred to as S.B.L. Number 195.00-3-7.1, situate in the Town of Hamburg and located adjacent to 18-Mile Creek, and

**WHEREAS**, this property is adjacent to Hamptonbrook Woods-Parcel 1, presently owned by the Town of Hamburg and Hamptonbrook Woods-Parcel 2, presently owned by the State of New York, and

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Hamburg, in conjunction with the State of New York, is willing to purchase said property, for an agreed upon purchase price of \$83,000, with the Town of Hamburg contributing \$23,800.00 and the State of New York contributing \$59,200.00, and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase will provide a completion of a linear green space corridor along 18-Mile Creek for public use, access and passive recreation,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town of Hamburg enter into a Purchase Agreement with Christopher and Jennifer Riefler for the purchase of the property legally known and identified as S.B.L. Number 195.00-3-1.1, and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legal Department is authorized to prepare any and all documents necessary to effectuate this transfer between the Riefler's, the Town of Hamburg and the State of New York.

Councilman Cavalcoli explains that this is a parcel that sits between two park lands now within the Town of Hamburg. The first parcel they purchased about 10 years ago. The State came through upon their request and purchased almost \$300,000 worth of property along 18 mile creek and the juncture. What was missing is this parcel connecting the two. They now have an agreement with Christopher and Jennifer Riefler to sell them 5.2 acres which allows them to connect the two parcels along 18 mile creek. It will allow for a continuous linear trail through there and they will be able to develop this. The State was willing to contribute \$59,200 towards the purchase of this property and the Town will contribute \$23,800 towards the purchase. The money will come out of the money in lieu of land and parks money from the trust and agency account. They have the money available and that money has been contributed for open space purchase as well as recreation. This is a good opportunity for the Town to link this together and preserve that access to 18 mile creek. This will take a minimum of 4 months to complete. When this is done this will be deeded to the State to look over and maintain. The Town would become the stewards of this.
