WHEREAS, the Town of Hamburg, in collaboration with the Erie County Water Authority, is committed to reducing the cost of municipal services, while remaining dedicated to ensuring enhanced levels of water service to all residents of the Town of Hamburg; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hamburg, in collaboration with the Erie County Water Authority, has determined that it is in the best interest of the Town of Hamburg taxpayers to have the Erie County Water Authority take over water service for the entire Town of Hamburg as a direct service provider, thereby eliminating all future involvement and responsibility of the Town with respect to the water system facilities within the Town of Hamburg, except for the payment of direct service hydrant maintenance fees to the Erie County Water Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hamburg, in collaboration with the Erie County Water Authority, is seeking capital funds to rehabilitate and improve the Town’s water system for this consolidation, in order to achieve municipal cost savings and property tax relief; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hamburg, in collaboration with the Erie County Water Authority, will share in the decision-making and approval processes related to this consolidation and subsequent ownership transfer; and

WHEREAS, the Hamburg Town Board and the Erie County Water Authority entered into a Memorandum of Understanding in May 2008, through which both parties mutually support the consolidation and subsequent transfer of ownership to the Erie County Water Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Hamburg received a request from John Kuebler to rezone property located on the east side of McKinley Parkway, south of Dorchester, from HC (Hamburg Commercial) to C-2; and

WHEREAS, the Code Review Committee reviewed the application and found merit in the rezoning of this property; and

WHEREAS, the Hamburg Town Board did refer this rezoning request to the Planning Board for its review and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, on October 15, 2008 the Planning Board forwarded a positive recommendation with conditions to the Town Board regarding this rezoning request; and

WHEREAS, the conditions of rezoning recommended by the Planning Board were forwarded to the Town Board for its review,

WHEREAS, the Town Board held the required public hearing and received comments from the public regarding this rezoning request on December 8, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the requested rezoning is in compliance with the Town of Hamburg Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Hamburg Town Board has issued a Negative Declaration;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Hamburg hereby rezones the parcel located on the east side of McKinley Parkway, south of Dorchester, from HC (Hamburg Commercial) to C-2 with the following conditions:

1. No access to Allendale Parkway shall be allowed.
2. The site plan submitted for the development of this property shall illustrate a 10 foot rear yard buffer area to the residential properties to the east. This area shall be landscaped and/or fenced in according with the Town's Zoning Code and to the satisfaction of the Town Planning Board.
3. A cross-access agreement between the property owner and the adjoining property owners shall be provided and potential access shall be shown on future development plans.
4. No automotive uses (filling stations, gasoline stations, automotive repair including oil change, muffler and brake shops, collision shops and tire shops, new and used motor vehicle sales, and car washes.) shall be allowed. The owner of the property shall submit a deed showing the above noted deed restrictions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the zoning code of the Town of Hamburg be amended as follows:

To amend Local Law #10 of the year 1986 of the code of the Town of Hamburg entitled "Zoning" to provide for a change in the boundary of the zoning map whereby the zoning is changed from HC to C-2

for property located on the east side of McKinley Parkway, south of Dorchester. The property is identified as S.B.L. Number 160.15-1-24.1

Councilwoman Kesner notes there were a couple of items the Board they wanted to fine tune for this project. One of the items she was concerned about was the ten foot rear buffer to the residential. She notes to her, this is not sufficient. Normally, they like to see 30-100'. She asks Mr. Smardz if this went back to the committee for that consideration to increase the buffer.

Councilman Smardz responds that the problem with the buffer is with this property you can't have a 100' buffer. The recommendation from the Planning Board is buffering whether it be a fence with vegetation so when the residents look out their back window they will see large vegetation with a fence and not a building.

Councilwoman Kesner adds but only ten feet. They wanted this increased as she recalls.

Councilman Smardz responds that the buffer cannot be increased to 30' with this property.

Councilwoman Kesner requests that this resolution be tabled.

Councilman Quatroche notes that he spoke to Mr. Kuebler and notes that whole area along McKinley has been a challenge for them. His concern is more of future use, he has spoken to Drew Reilly about adding some restaurant restrictions for smells and such. He doesn't see any of those in there and he would have to agree with Councilwoman Kesner to have this tabled.

Supervisor Walters responds that he thinks the biggest issue with this is that he saw Mr. Kuebler's site plans for this project and he thinks it's an excellent project for this area. It's a low traffic use for the property. He thinks the Planning Board needs to be cognizant of the neighbors behind. He notes that he believes this resolution should be moved forward. There is a Planning Board meeting this week, Wednesday, and Mr. Kuebler is on the agenda but will be removed if this resolution is not moved tonight.

Mr. Koenig responds that not necessarily because Wednesday is a work session. This could be on the agenda because it's a work session item and they would not take any action on it. This would give them more opportunity to review where they're at.

Supervisor Walters questions whether this is past tonight or if they wait until next week to move on this resolution, that would have no effect on the timing.

Mr. Koenig responds that he would say no, because the meeting on Wednesday is work session only.

Councilman Best notes that this resolution has been before the Board for almost a year now. If the code calls for 10' of buffer, we're giving them the ten feet. He's ready to vote on this tonight.

Councilwoman Kesner responds that personally she thinks ten feet from anyone's residential property is too close.

Councilman Quatroche asks Mr. Koenig if they introduce new items that were not at the work session at their regular meeting.

Councilwoman Kesner notes she would be interested moving this project forward in a timely manner with the little bit of fine tuning.
