### Old Business:

- Riefler Property – is close to closing with the Town's commitment. The DEC will have title. Tie the Town parcel to State parcel, 78 acres. Trail development and signage will be moving forward.
- Yovinne Project – working with National Fuel, and an engineering firm which reconstructed the design. A copy has been given to the Planning Board, Building Inspection his EAF will be reviewed as a team. The memo's request has been addressed on the new plans created by the engineering firm (this memo is on file with past minutes).

### New Business:

- *Gasland* was shown at the Hamburg Palace Theater on Saturday March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2011. These documentary discuses hydraulic fracturing, also known as fracking. Brad Gill from IOGA was present for questions and discussion.
