Meeting called to order at 7:00 pm by Ted Casey TSAB Coordinator

Motion made by E. Paolini, seconded by M. Bennett to accept the minutes from the February 20, 2014 meeting minutes. Motion carried.

Old Business:

1. Deer Crossing – request for deer crossing signage on Jeffrey Blvd. in the area of sewage treatment plant at the north end and UniFirst at the south end of the roadway. Request referred to the Department of Environmental Conservation, who returned the request with no recommendation for installation. Motion made by G. Paolini, seconded by C. Gillette to install deer crossing signs at the north and south ends of Jeffrey Blvd. supplemented with mileage sign. Motion carried unanimously.

2. Discussion of appointment of a planning board member to the TSAB – board noted that Sarah DesJardins previously attended TSAB meetings and has been an invaluable resource. Coordinator Casey to extend offer to Ms. DesJardin to attend future meetings as her schedule permits.

New Business:

1. Stop sign – request for stop sign on Brompton at Mosey Dr. Determined that the request does not meet volume warrants and stop signs are not meant to be used for speed control. Current controls are consistent with the NYS Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Request denied.
2. Deer Crossing – request for deer crossing signage on Keems Rd. near the ravine/bend in road. Determined traffic volume (dead end street) does not warrant signage. Request denied at this time.
3. Complaint of sidewalk on Route 20 at Riley Blvd. not plowed – is on front of Town of Hamburg Senior Building. Buildings and grounds department advised of complaint and they are complying.
4. Weight restriction signage – Loran Ave. resident concerned about apparent overweight/width vehicles on Loran Ave. Request referred to highway department.
5. Deer Crossing – request for deer crossing signage on Big Tree Rd. in the area of Bristol Rd. TSAB determined a need for the signage. Motion made by C. Cox, seconded by P. Ryan to install deer crossing signs on Big Tree Rd. in the area requested. Motion carried unanimously.

Other Business:

1. Speed concern – complaint from Bayview Rd. resident about speeding vehicles on Bayview Rd. between Big Tree Rd. and Riggs St. in the morning hours. Radar request to be sent to police department.

Motion made by G. Paolini, seconded by M. Bennett to adjourn meeting at 8:05pm. Motion carried.
