Site Plan Review:

- 1.) Tim Horton's @ Tops Plaza, TSAB recommends reconfiguration of store to reduce vehicle stacking and possible traffic backup at McKinley Pkwy. Exit.
Town will relocate No Turn on Red Sign @ McKinley exit and contact Erie County Hwy on crossover location.
- 2.) TSAB recommends turn around driveways for Dan Howard 4-lot subdivision
- 3.) Traffic Safety Board would request Supervisor Walters speak with Agricultural Society/ Casino, and State DOT representative on possible installation of traffic signal @ South Park Ave. entrance /exit

New Immediate Care Facility proposed for area will increase vehicle congestion on this section of highway.

TSAB has no adverse comments to the establishment of an Immediate Care Facility other than the aforementioned congestion at the fairgrounds drive.
